

ORDINANCE NO: 7.0109

Wildrose City Ordinance 7.0109 shall be amended to read as follows:

7.0109 Water & Sewer

The city water system and the sewer and waste treatment facilities as public utilities shall be operated in a manner to provide safe water and sewer water collection and treatment systems for the community of Wildrose. The water and waste disposal utilities are interrelated in providing unified and economical systems for the entire community. Except as otherwise provided, all persons or entities occupying residential properties, commercial and not for profit entities shall be required to use and patronize city's municipal water systems for all uses for human consumption, sanitation, household and commercial waste, food processing and food preparation. Except as otherwise provided, all persons or entities occupying resident properties, commercial and not for profit entities shall be required to use and patronize the city's sewer collection and waste treatment facilities and system exclusive of any other source, method, manner or location of disposal or treatment of wastewater and components of any nature as provided in this Code. Such water usage, and waste disposal and treatment shall be subject to fees, costs, assessments and other charges established in connection therewith. Except as otherwise herein provided, all sewage, wastewater and products are hereby required to be disposed of in full compliance with provisions of the Chapter 7.0109. Until the city has constructed municipal sewer collection and treatment approved by public health authorities may be maintained to service an individual property within the jurisdiction of the City of Wildrose.
