

City of Wildrose Special Meeting

July 16, 2020

Wildrose Fire/ City Hall

Call meeting to order, for a Special Meeting of the City of Wildrose, was held in the fire/ City Hall, Wildrose, ND on July 16, 2020. The meeting convened at 8:30 PM. Members of the Council in attendance, Mayor, Marlyn Vatne, President, Riley Reisig, V.P., Karla Magnuson, Sarah Herland and Todd Kragness.

No guests in attendance.

First order of business the burn pile on Carmody St., Councilman Todd Kragness dug a hole and proceeded to burn the pile of limbs and branches.

City Mowing & Hourly Rate: Motion by Magnuson for the P/T Seasonal Position to pay an hourly rate of \$15.00 per hour using the City Mower, 2nd by Herland. Vote: Ayes: Kragness, Herland, Magnuson and Reisig. Vote: Nay, None. Roll Call Vote: Kragness, Herland, Magnuson and Reisig. Motion Passed.

The Culvert at Fisk & 3rd Ave. motioned by Kragness to have Mr. Falk @ his hourly rate to design a grate to protect the culvert & vehicles from any further damage, 2nd by Herland. Vote: Ayes; Herland, Reisig, Magnuson and Kragness. Vote: Nays; None. Roll Call Vote: Kragness, Magnuson, Reisig and Herland. Motion Passed.

Motion by Herland for the P/T Seasonal Position City Ground Maintenance pay rate of \$25.00 per hour and to be under the direct supervision of the Mayor, 2nd by Reisig. Vote: Ayes, Reisig, Magnuson, Kragness and Herland. Vote: Nays; None. Roll Call Vote: Herland, Reisig, Magnuson and Kragness.

118 Main St. in Wildrose, the demolition of the building has been completed, Mayor Vatne asked council if the cement slab should also be removed. Council gave permission to Trailblader's to continue and remove the cement slab.

415 Main St. in Wildrose, discussion on whether to demolish or burn the building & shed. Mayor requested that MDU be called to remove the wires from the building and discuss with the Fire Department on the possibilities of burning of the buildings.

Motioned by Magnuson to adjourn the meeting t 9:14 PM, 2nd by Reisig. Vote: Ayes, Magnuson, Herland, Reisig and Kragness. Vote: Nays; None. Motion Passed.
